**Please Note:**

1. On the days of the examinations there will be bus transportation to Agalma Square right after the last examination of the day finishes. Transportation to residence is provided as usual at 1.55pm with regular buses.
2. After the examinations students will return to School until May 18. On these days, the students first will go over their final examinations and then will work on revision work of the material taught in Year 6. In September, the new year will start with new material and no revision of class 6 will be conducted.
3. Absences will be recorded until May 18.
